Purpose of Seeking CCA Association Fund Funding² - Proposal Abstract

Funding sought to assist in the efforts of Thornaby Chess Club to stage an event in a sports and leisure centre (Thornaby Pavilion) in Thornaby. Funding will be used to award additional prizes to CCA Members, thus encouraging their participation. The event will also be promoted in public places and special prizes will be awarded to non-club players, perhaps incentivising them to join a chess club.

PART III: Detailed Proposal Description

The event was conceived primarily to commemorate Thornaby Chess Club's tenth anniversary. However, it was decided that it should double as a memorial event in honour of Mike Closs, one of our founder members and most respected member of CCA. By staging the event in a busy public building like the Thornaby Pavilion, the profile of local chess will be greatly enhanced and there will be special prizes on offer for non-club players, thus encouraging (it is hoped) people to join a chess club and, of course, CCA. With CCA Association Fund sponsorship we can also offer additional prizes for existing CCA Members, thus encouraging participation. The event is also being sponsored by an individual for the amount of £100 and, as it is being run by Thornaby Chess Club, losses will be underwritten from account funds. So, although the event could still happen without CCA Association Fund sponsorship, I feel that the additional funding will enhance the event and reduce the risk to Thornaby Chess Club.
