2018-2019 (as at 31st May 2019)

I took on the CCA grader's job in August 2018 following a sudden vacancy occurring. Understandably, the CCA management committee did not want the season to get underway without knowing whether games would be graded! Thanks for their support, especially Julian Allinson for creating the Register of Members, and also to former CCA grader Mike Creaney for his advice and encouragement on getting started.

For the "statos" amongst the membership, here are a few facts and figures from the data received so far. All league, cup and association individual tournament games are included, but there may well be a few club championship games yet to arrive.
